#### Minister's Update - Cindy

• A survey from General Council asks for views especially on the structural change that eliminated the Presbytery level of UCC structure.

- Three stumps were removed from the circular garden at the front of the church, and a small team is looking at how the garden should be rebuilt. They will be consulting with an expert. A plan and budget will be sent to Council.
- June 15<sup>th</sup> 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary at EY Centre. Andrea will be sending out details of carpooling etc. There are many volunteer opportunities. We will be providing two items for the event museum: an early Affirming pin, and the architect's framed original design (on an airline napkin) for KUC.
- Cindy will be attending General Council in Calgary starting Aug. 5 and staying a few days longer as part of a group working on the strategic plan for the next ten years.

### Upcoming BBQ Planning & Council Assignments for Sunday June 8th:

Julia sent out detailed information from past years to guide Council's involvement.

We have an offer from Dawn and Ed Goodridge's son who is willing to bring his pizza oven and make two kinds of pizza, with donations requested. And we will use the excellent BBQ donated by Ron Allen for Bison Sliders and hotdogs Last year's 3 dozen sliders went fast so we will have 4 dozen this year). Robert will set up a sign-up sheet. Agreed to have essentially the traditional BBQ now and have pizza for our welcome-back lunch in the fall, with only salads as pot luck.

Several Council members will be away June 8, and Al will miss the June Council meeting. Robert will share a sign-up sheet.

# Congregational Workshops and Next Steps - All

- We have received Mary's report, and more ideas came out of last Friday's special Stewardship meeting. We will share the report and some ideas with the congregation, leading to sharing our action plan in the fall.
- The report is about 2 pages, plus a few pages of ideas recorded during the workshops. We will summarize for those who may not read that much information. We will put some of the content onto bulletin boards and the TV in the hallway.

#### **B&G** Status Report

The new B&G team has come up to speed, aided by having Tomasz handing most of the day to day maintenance. There are additional volunteers in the wings. Cindy and Andrea will be meeting with B&G.

Council discussed whether we should provide industrial strength vacuum etc. for church maintenance. We need to consult with the user before buying anything.

# Growth Journey / Stewardship - Robert

- It would help to have signs outside the building visible to visitors during the Book Fair. Words like safe space, for example. Send phrases to Cindy.
- There was an action from the AGM to have a discussion of stock donations. We have a person to lead it and will find a date probably in early fall. Perhaps a lunch after church based on one of Shawn's food ideas (make a little money?) and

including other topics not just stock donations.

# Review of Shawn's Stewardship Fundraising Ideas - All

- Stewardship Cttee currently Shawn and Julia. Small team of 4-5 would be ideal, and all should take the UCC course in the fall. Members will consider whether additional specific skills are needed, and Cindy will pass on any names from last year's Stewardship interests survey.
- Priorities exec summary and action plan will be sent soon.
- Kathy will provide a financial update for the June meeting.
- Marilyn has created a simple spreadsheet to track progress with our 5% growth in revenues and \$20K growth challenge.
- Compost sale and Flowers revenues way up (780 bags of compost!). Fundraising in general has gone well but we need to bolster PAR. We will have little fish tokens for people to put in the plate to represent their PAR contributions.
- Stewardship Fundraising Ideas: Dinner at KUC May 30. Fewer than half the people expected have signed up to date for the May 30 dinner. Starting additional publicity including Facebook groups such as Kanata Moms, and nearby churches. We can invite local politicians to mention it in their newsletters and attend themselves. Important that people sign up so that proper amounts of each food are bought.
- Fun Fair pushed to 2026. Create a team now for proper planning and preparation.
- Hoping to start Stewardship campaign right after Thanksgiving so that it is complete before our usual request for Christmas donations.
